The Gesubsidieerde Vrije Basisschool and the Sint-Jozefinstituut in Borsbeek were faced with a double problem. There was a severe lack of space and the school buildings were very dilapidated. That is why we decided to demolish the old school and build two new buildings in its place. One of the buildings is the new school building for all secondary education. It has an area of 7,023 m<sup>2</sup> and can accommodate 850 students. The second building houses the cafeteria and a 982 m<sup>2</sup> sports/polytechnic hall for the primary school. In addition to these two buildings, there is also a technical room with the distribution cabin and the meters for the utilities.
